

Board Meeting Oct 24, 2006
ECYH

Team Size on Squirt Level Play:

The board endured a lengthy discussion regarding the Squirt level Travel Tryouts. The board's intention is to roster 15 kids as discussed at earlier board meetings, but with 16 trying out, the board explored the possibility of roistering the 16th. The board decided not to extend the maximum 20 place roster as decided on B teams earlier in the year (with all non-goalie/skaters designated as alternates with no guaranteed game time – offered then parent/player choice vs. going to REC team). Instead, to encourage play and develop skills, the board invited kids cut to participate in travel practices for a fee, and to be roistered on a rec team. This, however, is not a usual situation and is not likely to be repeated. The circumstance driving this temporary variance from usual procedure is the low number of squirt travel players trying out which eliminates the possibility of a B travel team.

Team parent meeting – has to be next week – for travel peewee and squirt since picked, this will be set up by the travel committee.

Released 3 kids, two to Chippewa and one to Altoona – at their request, One Family is moving to Altoona as soon as their house is done being built. The other two kids have been skating in Chippewa. One is a girl who has been in the CF program for 3 years and the other is a mite.

REC – had coaches meeting with the coaches we could clearly identify as REC level coaches. Travel assured REC that Travel coach assignments will be completed in time for tryouts and draft.

A REC coach asked if his team could run a separate, and team focused fund raiser. The board did not entertain a motion for this given the current at large fund raisers and the upcoming capital and tournament sponsor campaigns. Therefore, the fund raiser for this team was not approved. Funds for additional tournaments need to be collected from Parents on a prorated basis by the team parent/manager.

Goalie Gear is not available for all for REC goalies. There is one set for Peewee and one set for Bantam. We are counting on sets from kids in the program, but the kids with gear have not been identified at this time. For those kids using the ECYH equipment, a 200 dollar deposit will be required and returned when the equipment is returned.

Dan G., facilities will provide the gear and the puck bags.
