## **Notice of Proposed Amendments to Bylaws**

In accordance with the bylaws, notice is hereby given that the following bylaw amendments will be considered at a membership meeting on \_\_\_\_\_ at \_\_\_\_\_

### **Current Bylaw**

As it reads

#### ARTICLE II MEMBERSHIP

There shall be one class of members, which shall consist of the parents of any player properly registered with an Eau Claire mini-mite hockey program, an Eau Claire Parks and Recreation Department youth hockey program, or a program of the Youth Hockey Club of Eau Claire. Each parent shall receive one vote for each child enrolled. No child shall have more than two voting parents. **Registration eligibility for programs of the Youth Hockey Club of Eau Claire shall be limited to players residing within the boundaries of the Eau Claire area School District and formally enrolled in school in Eau Claire. A waiver from the eligibility requirement may be granted by the Board of Directors to a non-resident player if (1) the player resides in an area which is not served by another youth hockey association and to which the Youth Hockey Club is the nearest active hockey association and (2) the Board of Directors find such a waiver would be in the best interests of the purposes of this organization.**

### **Proposed Bylaw with Amendment**

Bylaw as it will read if adopted

#### ARTICLE II MEMBERSHIP

There shall be one class of members, which shall consist of the parents of any player properly registered with an Eau Claire mini-mite hockey program, an Eau Claire Parks and Recreation Department youth hockey program, or a program of the Youth Hockey Club of Eau Claire. Each parent shall receive one vote for each child enrolled. No child shall have more than two voting parents. **Registration eligibility for programs of the Youth Hockey Club of Eau Claire shall be limited to players (1) formally enrolled in school in Eau Claire or an approved DPI home study program and (2) residing within the boundaries of the Eau Claire area School District. A waiver of the eligibility requirement may be granted to a non-district player following WAHA eligibility rules and regulations, if (1) the player receives written permission from their residing association and (2) the Board of Directors find such eligibility would be in the best interests of the purposes of this organization**

### **Rationale**

This would allow the home schooled student's proper enrollment in the Youth Hockey Club of Eau Claire. This would allow the Board to consider non-district players to participate in the Youth Hockey Club of Eau Claire for special circumstances which would be in the best interests of the association. (eg. Inadequate numbers registered for programs of the association.)
